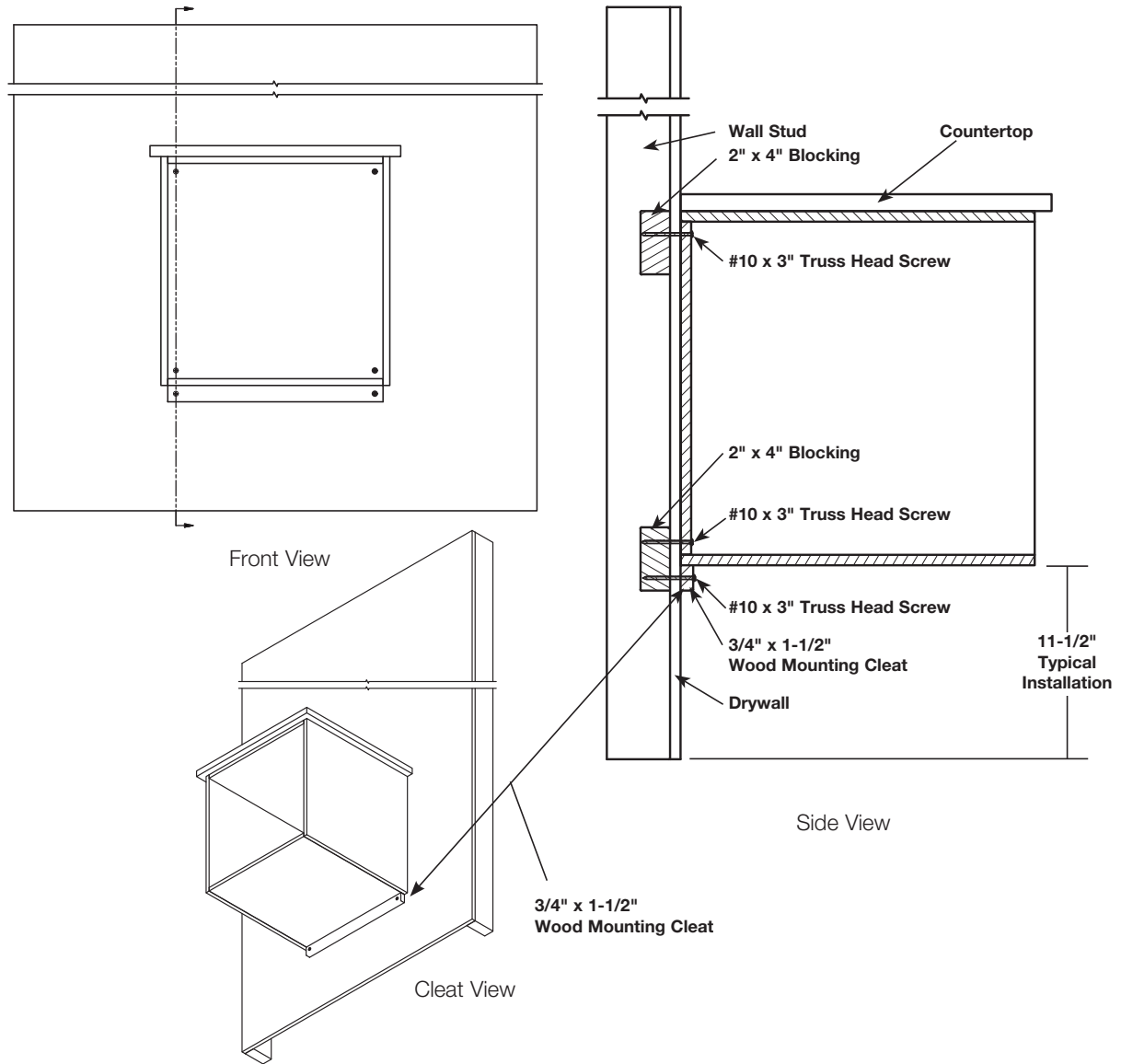


FLOATING VANITY CABINET INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



- Floating vanities have a weight limit of 300 lbs. (including countertops) when installed properly
- **DO NOT STAND ON THEM**
- Floating vanities should be anchored to the wall studs using a minimum of four (4) #10x3" Truss head cabinet mounting screws, with (minimum) one screw anchored no more than 6" from each end panel, and the remaining screws installed at equal intervals in between
- Floating vanities should also be supported underneath by a securely installed leg, cleat, or heavy-duty floating vanity bracket
- Wall blocking is strongly recommended to increase weight bearing capacity of the cabinet installation
- Floating vanities come with solid tops to increase stability and strength; solid tops should not be altered other than to remove the minimum amount needed to install a sink on EFVS___ cabinets
